Welcome Letter

Dear Potential Counselee:

1. I would like to take this opportunity to welcome you to Grace Biblical Counseling Ministry which is a Discipleship/Biblical counseling ministry of Waters Edge Bible Church. The purpose of this ministry is to help you meet the challenges of life in a way that will please and honor the Lord Jesus Christ. We are confident that the Bible has all of the information necessary for life and godliness (2 Peter 1:3) and that there are no problems which the Bible fails to address either in general or in specific principles. Therefore, your counseling will be Biblical in which the Scriptures are the final authority in all cases (2 Timothy 3:16-17). In other words, there will be NO secular or psychological influences in our counseling. However, you are fully responsible for how you implement that advice.

2. Even though there is <u>no mandatory charge</u> for this ministry, we do ask for a \$40 administrative fee (to be paid during the first session) to cover the cost of reading materials and supplies that may be provided to you for your benefit. The counselor may also recommend that you purchase additional books to aid in your Christian growth. If you are unable to pay the \$40, it will be waived in good faith. Although this Biblical counseling service is provided without charge, Waters Edge Bible Church accepts freewill offerings which will be used to continue to provide excellent Biblical counseling and to expand this ministry.

3. We recognize and respect the authority and discipline of the local church. Therefore, it is important that Biblical counseling sessions be accompanied by church activities that encourage discipleship and fellowship (Hebrews 10:24-25). If you are a member of another church family, the assistance of your church's leadership may be requested. Your pastor, elder, or deacon may even become a part of your counseling team. If you are not a member of a church, we will expect you to attend Waters Edge Bible Church during the period of counseling.

4. Our Biblical Counselor's time is limited and is in high demand by those requesting Biblical counseling. If you must cancel or reschedule a counseling session, please notify your Biblical Counselor directly at least 24 hours prior to your scheduled counseling session. Of course, in emergencies, exceptions are made. For scheduling purposes, please be advised that the counseling period lasts an average of between 8 to 12 sessions. Please allow at least 2 hours for the first session, and 1 hour for all subsequent sessions. 5. Since the Bible says that every believer needs to continually examine himself (1 Corinthians 11:28) and be an effectual doer of the Word (James 1:22-25), homework will be assigned during each session to assist you in implementing the Biblical principles learned during the counseling. It is important, therefore, that you bring writing paper, pen, and your Bible to <u>ALL</u> sessions. If you are unwilling to use the Bible as the final authority in counseling or unwilling to do the homework assigned, sessions will be terminated.

6. If you are interested in pursuing Biblical counseling through Grace Biblical Counseling Ministry, kindly fill out the attached Request for Biblical Counseling Form and email it to GraceMinistriesCounseling@gmail.com. Each person requesting counseling must fill out a form, so please feel free to copy the form as necessary. We ask that you complete the Request for Biblical Counseling form and submit it to us at least a week ahead of your scheduled first appointment. During the first session, you will be asked to sign a Grace Biblical Counseling Ministry Informed Consent to Biblical Counseling and Discipleship Form which further explains our Biblical counseling ministry.

7. We believe you will receive encouragement and hope from the Scriptures even during the first session (Romans 15:4). From then on, with your cooperation, we believe a trustworthy and Biblical answer to your difficulty will be found. In the meantime, I would like to leave you with this verse from Scripture, "And God is able to make all grace abound to you, that always having all sufficiency in everything, you may have an abundance for every good deed" (2 Corinthians 9:8). May God richly bless you!

GRACE* BIBLICAL COUNSELING MINISTRY INFORMED CONSENT TO BIBLICAL COUNSELING & DISCIPLESHIP

<u>Our Goal</u>: The purpose of biblical counseling and discipleship is to help you meet the challenges of life in a way that will please and honor the Lord Jesus Christ. We offer counseling and discipleship free of charge, as a ministry of Waters Edge Bible Church. Counselees may choose to make a freewill offering to the ministry, but this is not expected or required as a condition of counseling. You have no express or implied obligation to pay fees for the ministry you receive through Grace Biblical Counseling Ministry.

<u>Biblical Basis</u>: Grace Biblical Counseling Ministry counseling is strictly <u>religious</u> in nature, conducted under the authority and leadership of the <u>church</u>. We believe that God, through His revelation in the Old and New Testaments of the Bible, has provided His people with thorough guidance and instruction for faith and life (2 Timothy 3:16-17; 2 Peter 1:3-4). Our counseling is based solely on scriptural principles. We reject the teachings and methods of modern psychology or psychiatry, whether expressly secular or an attempted integration with biblical principles. Grace Biblical Counseling Ministry counselors are <u>not</u> trained or licensed as psychotherapists, or mental health professionals. They do not follow the methods, theories, or practices of such persons, and our policy is to <u>not</u> make referrals to them. Our counselors are engaged in a strictly religious practice under the supervision of ordained clergy, and accordingly, are not state-licensed. *See* Fla. Stat. §§ 490.014(2)(f) [Exemptions – "Psychological Services"], 491.014(3), 4(b), 4(c), and 4(d) ["Exemptions – Clinical, Counseling, and Psychotherapy Services"].

As a Christian religious ministry founded on biblical truth, Grace Biblical Counseling Ministry recognizes marriage <u>only</u> as the union of one man and one woman, as God ordained in Genesis 2:24-25. Grace Biblical Counseling Ministry counselors offer compassionate ministry to persons desiring to leave a sinful lifestyle but will not affirm any other arrangement as a valid marriage, regardless of any contrary definition that has been or in the future may be adopted by the civil authorities.

<u>Other Professional Advice</u>: If you have significant medical, legal, financial, or other technical questions, you should seek advice from a competent independent professional. Our counselors will cooperate with such advisors and help you to consider their counsel in the light of scriptural principles.

More specifically, we urge our counselees to properly care for their physical bodies and to seek proper medical treatment for all physiological problems. Our counselors will assist you in responding to such problems in a godly manner, but our counsel is not intended to replace the services of a qualified physician where organic problems are present or where medication has been prescribed.

<u>Confidentiality</u>: Confidentiality is an important aspect of the counseling process. We will carefully guard the information you entrust to us to the fullest extent possible. There are times, however, when it may be necessary for us to share certain information with others. Examples include, but are not limited to, the following:

1. Where a person refuses to renounce a particular sin, it may become necessary to seek the assistance of others in the church to encourage repentance and reconciliation (Proverbs 15:22,

24:11; Matthew 18:15-20). In such cases, we will reveal only such information as is necessary for such purposes, and only to those biblically required to be involved. Where a counselee is a member of another church, it may be necessary to contact the pastor and/or elder(s) of such church.

2. Where a counselor is uncertain as to how to address a particular counseling issue, he may seek advice from a pastor or another counselor.

3. Where a counselee threatens harm to themselves or another person, it may be necessary to intervene in order to prevent such harm.

4. The law may require a counselor to reveal spousal or child abuse, or some other crime, to the appropriate authorities.

5. Observers may sit in on counseling sessions to assist or for training purposes.

<u>Conflict Resolution - Arbitration</u>: On rare occasions, a conflict may develop between a counselor and counselee. 1 Corinthians 6:1-8 forbids Christians from bringing lawsuits against one another in secular courts of law. In order to ensure that such conflicts are resolved in a biblically faithful manner, we require all of our counselees to agree that any dispute with a counselor or with this church will be settled by mediation and, if necessary, legally binding arbitration conducted in accordance with the *Rules of Procedure* of the Institute for Christian Conciliation (a copy is available upon request). The arbiters will be the Elders of Waters Edge Bible Church. It is expressly understood that, by consenting in advance to such arbitration, the counselee is waiving his right to a trial in the civil courts.

<u>Release of Records</u>: It is our policy not to release Grace Biblical Counseling Ministry records for a particular counselee without that person's written consent, or, in case of counseling a married couple or other counseling involving multiple members of the same family, the written consent of each person involved. If a counselee is under age 18, that counselee's parent or legal guardian must sign. If a subpoena or other legal demand requires Grace Biblical Counseling Ministry to release counseling records, Grace Biblical Counseling Ministry will notify the person(s) whose records must be released.

Having clarified the principles and policies of our counseling ministry, we welcome the opportunity to minister to you in the name of Christ and to be used by Him as He helps you grow in spiritual maturity and prepares you for usefulness in His body.
